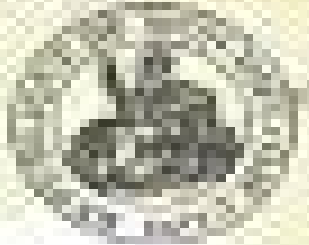

CityU TESOL Certificate Credit Challenge

- Students who wish to transfer TESOL Certificate courses into a CityU M.Ed Degree program will have to challenge them by:
 - Passing a subject exam in TESOL 510 & 530
 - Completing a subject project at 80% or higher in TESOL 525 & 540
 - \$400 Project fee per certificate
- Transfer must include all 4 courses
 - TESOL 9510 Principles of Language Learning and Teaching (exam)
 - TESOL 9525 Methods of Teaching Language (project)
 - TESOL 9530 Teaching Grammar (exam)
 - TESOL 9540 Strategies for Teaching the Four Skills (project)
